Dear Awana Commanders, Leaders, Clubbers, and Parents,

Big Sky Scholarship Camp is coming up soon, August 1-7. What is Scholarship Camp? It is an *incentive* for Awana clubbers to finish their handbook. The growth, great times, and friendships of the club year are intensified into seven days of spiritual growth and fun! Daily Bible Lessons, verse memorization, chapel, and service opportunities are just some of the ways in which the campers will be challenged to grow in their spiritual walk with the Lord. The High School campers will be offered ministry training and service opportunities. Scholarship Camp offers a week of four team competition in games, activities (including the unique Water Works!), Bible quizzing, and the completion of daily Bible lessons. Campers have the opportunity to meet old and new friends from around the Mountain West. The positive environment of Scholarship Camp helps clubbers to make important decisions for Christ that will last a lifetime and make a positive impact for God's kingdom.

What is Big Sky Strategic Ministries (BSSM)? It is a nonprofit 501C(3) organization formed by five couples in 2004 with a passion for the Awana ministry. When Awana stopped their camping ministry in 2006, BSSM established Big Sky Scholarship Camp to continue the ministry to motivate Awana clubbers to finish their books so they can have at camp great fun, learn more about Jesus, meet new friends, and to learn to serve Him now. Over the years we have seen that Camp Alumni make great *Leaders in Training* for your club.

BSSM has guaranteed payment to Yellowstone Alliance Adventures Camp for a minimum of 80 campers and there are many openings left that we don't want to go unfilled. We are trusting God to provide. Please encourage all eligible clubbers to apply. For clubbers to be eligible, they must 1) be entering 6th grade this fall through graduating seniors, 2) be at least 10 years old by the first day of camp, 3) for the first time camper, have completed one year's Awana handbook requirements OR for returning campers, have completed one additional year's Awana handbook requirements, in the current handbook progression (T&T or higher). All work must be completed before camp begins. We would like to offer financial scholarship funds to clubbers that would like to come to camp but would not be able to do so without some assistance. If you know of clubbers with a financial need, please encourage them to apply for a financial scholarship. Application information is available at our *bigskystratmin.org* website.
