What is Scholarship Camp? Scholarship Camp is a ministry to motivate Awana clubbers to finish their books so they can have great fun, learn more about Jesus, meet new friends, learn to serve Him now, and want to finish another book to come back again. Daily Bible Lessons, verse memorization, and chapel are just some of the ways in which the campers will be challenged to grow in their spiritual walk with the Lord. The High School campers will have ministry training and an outreach opportunity. Scholarship Camp offers a week of four team competition in games, activities, Bible quizzing, and the completion of daily Bible lessons and verses. The positive environment of Scholarship Camp helps clubbers to make important decisions for Christ that will last a lifetime and make a positive impact for God's kingdom.

Scholarship Camp is for Awana clubbers who finish their handbooks and will be going into the 6th grade (10 years old) through just graduated Seniors. First year campers must have finished one year's handbook(s) (T&T or higher). Returning campers must have completed one additional year's handbook(s). All work must be completed before the camper application is submitted.

We are trusting God to provide funds through generous friends of Scholarship Camp for us to give Scholarships to those who earn major awards this year (\$200 for Citation, \$120 for Meritorious, \$80 for Timothy) and for those in financial need (via Financial Scholarship Application). Our desire is that every eligible clubber that wants to come to camp has the opportunity, as funds are available. Go to the BSSCamp Website for information to donate to the Scholarship Fund.

The total cost for campers is \$240 (\$200 camp fee & \$40 registration fee) for a 7 day camp, from Saturday afternoon to Saturday morning.
