MUSIC: This team will be preparing for and leading the song and ministry service ** This team includes those persons skilled in compute, video projection, and sound.

TESTIMONIES: This team will prepare and give their individual personal testimonies **. Consider how you faith journey began and what has God been doing in your life since.

GOSPEL PRESENTATIONS: This team will practice various methods of presenting the Gospel and use role plays to demonstrate them **.
