Would you be willing to pray, asking God to raise up a Camp Contact for your Awana Club? Pray that God would raise up someone who would be willing to do some of the following helpful ideas ...

- 1) **distribute** information about Big Sky Scholarship Camp to leaders, clubbers, and parents in your Awana Club.
- 2) be an point of contact to **answer questions** about Camp **or refer** people to the Camp Website or Camp Registrar or Camp Director.
- 3) make a **list** of TNT, Trek, and Journey **eligible clubbers** who have not been to camp before and have already finished one Awana year book requirements (TnT & up) and/or who have already earned their Timothy or Meritorious Award requirements. Then **inform** those clubbers and their parents about their eligibility to go to Scholarship Camp.
- 4) make a **list** of TNT, Trek, and Journey **eligible clubbers** who have a chance at finishing their Awana book requirements and/or who have a chance at finishing their Timothy, Meritorious, or Citation Award requirements for this year. Then **inform** those clubbers and their parents about Camp.
- 5) make a **list** of leaders **interested** in helping out at Camp.
- 6) assemble a **prayer team** from your Awana Club and Church to pray for leaders and clubbers to be able to go to Camp.
- 7) **help promote** Scholarship Camp at major Awana Events during the Club Year.
- 8) do **Bible Council Times** on Scholarship Camp in your Club.
- 9) **present** Camp Scholarship **Certificates** at your club's Awards Night to those who finish their Awana book requirements and the recipients of the Timothy, Meritorious & Citation Awards that are eligible to come to Camp.
- 10) **assist** the prospective campers in **completing** their Camp **Application** and Scholarship Camp Application as needed.
- 11) **coordinate** available **transportation** between parents and leaders going to Camp.

- 1) to help Awana Clubbers work in and finish their handbooks and grow in a personal, intimate relationship with Jesus Christ?
- 2) to train the youth in their Awana Club to serve our Lord Jesus Christ?
